### Summary of investigation

May to October 2023

#### Organisation or person investigated

Big Innovation Centre ("BIC")

#### Matter(s) investigated

Whether BIC conducted unregistered consultant lobbying

#### Registrar's decision

Based on assurances received, BIC has not conducted unregistered consultant lobbying activity.

#### Summary of rationale for decision

Based on substantive and unequivocal written information from BIC, no registerable communications have taken place. Where BIC provides secretariat services for All-Party Parliamentary Groups ("APPGs"), all communications with ministers are undertaken by APPG parliamentary officers.

Under the Transparency of Lobbying, Non-Party Campaigning and Trade Union administration Act (2014), a registrable communication is made by a VAT registered company or individual communicating with a Minister, Permanent Secretary (or equivalent) on behalf of a paying client. BIC provided assurance that no such communication has taken place.

10 August	Formal investigation letter from the Registrar giving background on the requirement for registering and asking if BIC's activities fall within the criteria to be registered with particular reference to, but not limited to, any communications made on behalf of APPGs.
5 Sept	Registrar issues a formal Information Notice, following no response.
26 Sept	Email response from BIC.
3 Oct	Letter from Registrar with a follow up question.
3 Oct	Email response from BIC.
6 Oct	Email from Office with a follow up question regarding ministerial contact by an APPG.
9 Oct	Email response from BIC.
23 Oct	Letter from Registrar concluding his investigation.
